

## **FAQs**

- 1.) Are we traveling with AFA from Mississippi to the Ark? No, everyone is expected to find their own transportation to the Marriott Cincinnati Airport hotel located at 2307-2243 Progress Dr., Hebron, KY 41048.
- 2.) Where else can I stay if the Marriott Cincinnati Airport hotel is full? If you cannot stay at the Marriott, below is a list of nearby hotels. (Note: These will **not** offer the discounted rate the Marriott Cincinnati Airport provides.)
  - Hampton Inn Cincinnati Airport-North, 755 Petersburg Rd, Hebron, KY 41048
  - Comfort Suites Cincinnati Airport: 775 Petersburg Rd, I-275 Exit 4A, Hebron, KY 41048
  - Country Inn & Suites by Radisson, Cincinnati Airport, KY: 759 Petersburg Rd, Hebron, KY 41048
- 3.) Where do I go to get on the charter buses? Everyone will load the charter buses at the Marriott Cincinnati Airport hotel. Whether you are staying at the Marriott or not, you must go to this hotel to ride on the charter buses with AFA staff and other attendees.
- 4.) Will someone from American Family Association attend this event? Yes, two of our vice presidents, Wesley Wildmon and Tony Vitagliano, will be part of this special weekend event. They look forward to fellowshipping with everyone attending.
- 5.) I have a special diet; can you accommodate my needs with the meals you provide? If any of our meals do not suit your diet needs, you should bring your own.

The charter buses are not handicap-equipped, so if you are wheelchair-bound, you will need your own transportation to the Ark Encounter and Creation Museum. However, if you use a wheelchair due to an injury or other condition but can climb into the bus, your wheelchair can be stored in the cargo area underneath.
- 7.) Do the Ark Encounter and Creation Museum have scooters available for visitors? Yes, both locations have scooters for rent (at your own cost).
- 8.) Is there any event scheduled for Saturday, November 2? No, Saturday is check-out. This special event concludes on Friday night, November 1.
